  same disclosure events mentioned above.
- Please note that the information contained in a BrokerCheck report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the broker or brokerage firm, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.
- Where did this information come from?
- The information contained in BrokerCheck comes from FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD® and is a combination of:
  - o information FINRA and/or the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) require brokers and brokerage firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and

> investment recommendations to only municipal bonds. My recommendation to purchase the preferred stock at issue was suitable for and consistent with the



client's stated investment objective and risk tolerance at the time. I consulted with the client prior to purchasing the preferred stock and we reviewed the features of the preferred stock. The client approved and authorized the purchase prior to execution. Further, the client received a trade confirmation memorializing the purchase of the preferred stock on or about April 10, 2014 and received monthly statements for two years prior to his complaint which listed the investment under the category of "Preferreds" rather than "Municipal Bonds." The client later recalled authorizing the purchase. The firm responded to the client denying his allegations. Accordingly, there should be no liability or wrongdoing on my part associated with this complaint.
